BUYING ETHEREUM IN TW

- Get TrustWallet app installed and setted up in your Smartphone
- As QAO is based in ethereum we will need to get some before swapping it to QAO.
- You can either directly buy it in TrustWallet or transfer it from a diferent source to your TrustWallet ETH address



TRANSFERING ETHEREUM TO TW

Navigate to your ethereum wallet and select "Receive"

FEES AND CONFIRMATION

Once you click on "Swap" it will show some details about the transaction:



- Then a confirmation will show up in your TrustWallet WalletConnect option. In there you will be able to verify one last time the details.
- The fees that you will see are out of QAO control. It's related to ethereum. The more transactions ETH is having the higher the fees are going to be.If you feel like the fees are too high you might want to try again later.
